




















## Rebuke — what is not RIGHT


<sup>8</sup> Do not rebuke mockers or they will hate you; rebuke the wise and they will love you.


<sup>9</sup> Instruct the wise and they will be wiser still; teach the righteous and they will add to their learning.





























- <sup>5</sup> Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;
