









- Is aware of his or her **WEAKNESSES**.

- Considers others more highly than him or herself.




#### The humble person...

- Asks for **TEEDBACK** even when it is not offered.




ACTIVELY seek wisdom and instruction as if your LIFE depended on it.





- <sup>7</sup> The beginning of wisdom is this: Get wisdom. Though it cost all you have, get understanding.









Those who pursue wisdom...

Ask questions to others for added clarity and understanding instead of jumping to share an opinion on a matter.






Learn from the right teachers.

<sup>20</sup>Walk with the wise and become wise, for a companion of fools suffers harm.






Learn from the right teachers.




There are many <u>smooth-talking</u> fools out there as well as <u>soft-spoken</u> wise people.
